We use this after unvoiced sounds like, p, k, sh, ch, gh, f, th, ss, c, x. EG: wish - wished

L pulled  
M seemed  
N cleaned  
R offered  
G begged  
V moved  
Oy enjoyed  
Z amazed

We use this after the final sounds d and t It is said as another syllable

T wanted

D needed  
D waded

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
