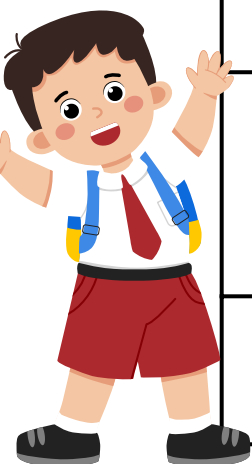


# Is it tch or ch?

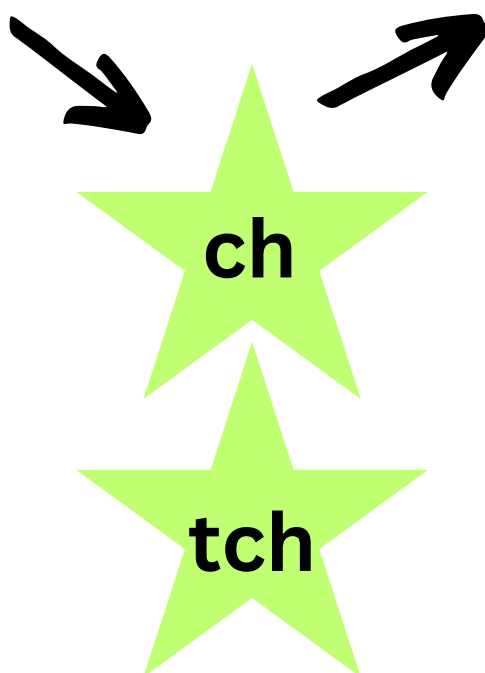


Take a look at the rules below to help you learn how to spell these tricky ch and tch words.

Situation	Rule Description	Examples
After a Consonant	Use 'ch' when the 'ch' sound follows a consonant.	search, church
After a Single-Letter Vowel	Use 'tch' after a single-letter vowel.	fetch, catch, pitch
After a Two-Letter Vowel	Use 'ch' after a vowel team (two vowels).	beach, teach, crouch
