Mum gave them **warm towels** and **hot chocolate**.

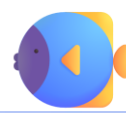
Liam smiled. “Rainy days can be fun, too!”

Then she laughed. "I guess we all need a taste!"

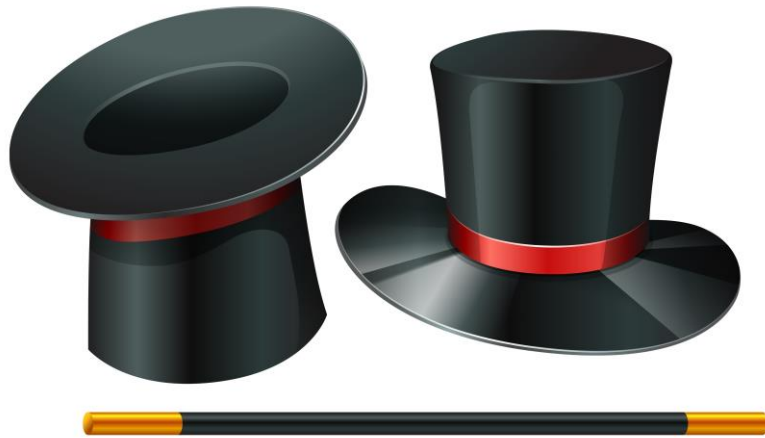
She gave them each a **small spoonful of icing** before lighting the candles.
